House Bill No. 1114

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1114 - By: ERWIN of the House and GUMM of the Senate.

An Act relating to state employees; amending Section 17, Chapter 347, O.S.L. 2002 (74 O.S. Supp. 2002, Section 842), which relates to vendor access to state employees; modifying conditions for vendor access to state employees; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 17, Chapter 347, O.S.L. 2002 (74 O.S. Supp. 2002, Section 842), is amended to read as follows:

Section 842. ~~The Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management shall promulgate rules to~~ A. Effective July 1, 2003, state agencies shall allow product vendors that have an authorized payroll deduction for state employees pursuant to Section 7.10 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes reasonable access to state employees in order to provide information concerning their products. In cooperation with the individual state agencies, vendors shall be allowed, at a minimum, annual access to state employees for such purpose. This access shall only occur during ~~nonworking hours~~ scheduled breaks or during periods immediately before or after normal work hours and must not disrupt or interfere with the

1 business of the agency. For those state government facilities that
2 operate twenty-four (24) hours a day, vendors shall be allowed
3 access for each shift. State funds shall not be utilized to
4 accommodate this access.

5 B. The Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management may
6 promulgate rules necessary to implement this section.

7 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
