ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1832 - By: PAULK and NANCE of the House and HELTON of the Senate.

An Act relating to the firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1289.24, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 465, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 1289.24), which relates to state preemption of firearm regulation; adding exception to state preemption; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1289.24, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 465, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 1289.24), is amended to read as follows:

FIREARM REGULATION - STATE PREEMPTION

Section 1289.24 A. 1. The State Legislature hereby occupies and preempts the entire field of legislation in this state touching in any way firearms, components, ammunition, and supplies to the complete exclusion of any order, ordinance, or regulation by any municipality or other political subdivision of this state. Any existing or future orders, ordinances, or regulations in this field, except as provided for in paragraph 2 of this subsection and subsection C of this section, are null and void. ~~Provided, however,~~
