6 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1890 - By: ELLIS,
7 ROAN, SMITHSON and NANCE of the House and HELTON and CORN of the
8 Senate.

9 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2001,
10 Section 15-111, which relates to parking for physically
11 disabled persons; certain disabled veteran plates allowed
12 special parking privileges; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section
13 1136, as last amended by Section 46 of Enrolled House Bill
14 No. 2725 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma
15 Legislature, which relates to special license plates;
16 creating disabled veterans plate with certain accessibility
17 symbol; providing a preemption for the enforcement of
18 registration and licensing of automobiles; prohibiting the
19 enactment or enforcement of certain municipal orders,
20 ordinances, or regulations; providing for codification; and
21 providing an effective date.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 15-111, is
24 amended to read as follows:

25 Section 15-111. A. Municipalities and political subdivisions
26 of the state with authority to regulate the standing or parking of
27 vehicles may extend special parking privileges to a physically
28 disabled person who displays on a motor vehicle operated by or under
29 the direction and for the use of the physically disabled person:

1 1. A placard indicating physical disability, issued pursuant to
2 the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title; or

3 2. A physical disability license plate or disabled veterans
4 license plate with the international accessibility symbol, issued
5 pursuant to the provisions of Section 1136 of this title.

6 B. No such special parking privilege, however, shall excuse the
7 violation of any state statute, nor shall any such privilege be
8 applicable where the standing or parking would create a dangerous
9 situation or impede the normal flow of traffic. Nothing in this
10 section shall be construed as requiring the creation of additional
11 parking spaces.

12 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 1136, as
13 amended by Section 46 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2725 of the 2nd
14 Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
15 follows:

16 Section 1136. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized
17 to design and issue appropriate official special license plates as
18 provided by this section.

19 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
20 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
21 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
22 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
23 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
7 issued on a staggered system except for legislative and motorcycle
8 license plates and vintage decals.

9 If fewer than fifty of any type of special license plates
10 authorized prior to January 1, 2000, are issued prior to January 1,
11 2005, or, for any type of special license plate authorized after
12 January 1, 2000, within five (5) years after first being offered,
13 the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance of that type of
14 special license plate.

15 Special license plates shall be designed in such a manner as to
16 identify the use and ownership of the vehicle. The special license
17 plates provided by this section are as follows:

18 1. Political Subdivision Plates - such plates shall be designed
19 for any vehicle owned by any political subdivision of this state and
20 shall be registered for Five Dollars (\$5.00), after having obtained
21 proper Oklahoma certificate of title. Such political subdivisions
22 shall file an annual report with the Tax Commission stating the
23 agency where such vehicle is located. Such license plates shall be

1 permanent in nature and designed in such a manner as to remain with
2 the vehicle for the duration of the life span of the vehicle or
3 until the title is transferred to an owner who is not a political
4 subdivision;

5 2. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
6 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
7 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
8 district number.

9 The fee for such plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall
10 be in addition to the regular plate issued to the member and the
11 fees charged therefor;

12 3. Tax-Exempt or Nonprofit License Plates - such plates shall
13 be designed for:

14 a. any motor bus, manufactured home, or mobile chapel and
15 power unit owned and operated by a religious
16 corporation or society of this state holding a valid
17 exemption from taxation issued pursuant to Section
18 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C.,
19 Section 501(a), and listed as an exempt organization
20 in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as
21 amended, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c) (3), and that is
22 used by the corporation or society solely for the
23 furtherance of its religious functions,

- 1 b. any vehicle owned and operated only by nonprofit
2 organizations devoted exclusively to youth programs
3 including, but not limited to, the Girl Scouts and Boy
4 Scouts of America,
- 5 c. any vehicle, except passenger automobiles, owned or
6 operated by nonprofit organizations actually involved
7 in programs for the employment of the handicapped and
8 used exclusively in the transportation of goods or
9 materials for such organization,
- 10 d. any vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit
11 organization that provides older persons
12 transportation to and from medical, dental and
13 religious services and relief from business and social
14 isolation,
- 15 e. any vehicle owned and operated by a private nonprofit
16 organization that:
- 17 (1) warehouses and distributes surplus foods to other
18 nonprofit agencies and organizations, and
- 19 (2) holds a valid exemption from taxation issued
20 pursuant to Section 501(c) of the Internal
21 Revenue Code, as amended, 26 U.S.C., Section
22 501(c), and listed as an exempt organization in

1 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code,
2 as amended, and

3 (3) uses such vehicle exclusively for the
4 transportation of such surplus foods, or

5 f. any vehicle which:

6 (1) is owned and operated by a private, nonprofit
7 organization which is exempt from taxation
8 pursuant to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3)
9 of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section
10 501(c)(3), and which is primarily funded by a
11 fraternal or civic service organization with at
12 least one hundred local chapters or clubs, and

13 (2) is designed and used to provide mobile health
14 screening services to the general public at no
15 cost to the recipient, and for which no
16 reimbursement of any kind is received from any
17 health insurance provider, health maintenance
18 organization or governmental program.

19 The registration fee shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00).

20 Any person claiming to be eligible for a tax-exempt or nonprofit
21 license plate under the provisions of this paragraph must have the
22 name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit organization prominently
23 displayed upon the outside of the vehicle, except those vehicles

1 registered pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph b of this
2 paragraph, unless such display is prohibited by federal or state law
3 or by state agency rules. No vehicle shall be licensed as a tax-
4 exempt or nonprofit vehicle unless the vehicle has affixed on each
5 side thereof, in letters not less than two (2) inches high and two
6 (2) inches wide, the name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit
7 organization or the insignia or other symbol of such organization
8 which shall be of sufficient size, shape and color as to be readily
9 legible during daylight hours from a distance of fifty (50) feet
10 while the vehicle is not in motion;

11 4. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
13 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
14 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
15 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
16 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
17 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
18 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
19 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
20 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
21 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
22 (1) ton or less. The registration fee shall be Five Dollars
23 (\$5.00);

1 5. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
3 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
4 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
5 required to provide proof of eligibility annually. The fee for such
6 plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all
7 other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
8 Registration Act;

9 6. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
11 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
12 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
13 required to provide proof of eligibility annually. The fee for such
14 plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all
15 other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
16 Registration Act;

17 7. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
18 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
19 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
20 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
21 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
22 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
23 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying

1 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
2 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or
3 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
4 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
5 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
6 to provide proof of eligibility annually. The fee for such plates
7 shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
8 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
9 Registration Act;

10 8. Physically Disabled License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for persons who are eligible for an insignia as a
12 physically disabled person under the provisions of Section 15-112 of
13 this title. It shall prominently display the international
14 accessibility symbol, which is a stylized human figure in a
15 wheelchair. The Tax Commission shall also design physically
16 disabled license plates for motorcycles owned by persons who are
17 eligible for an insignia as a physically disabled person pursuant to
18 the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title. Upon the death of
19 the physically disabled person, the special license plate shall be
20 returned to the Tax Commission. There shall be no fee for such
21 plate in addition to the rate provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle
22 License and Registration Act for the registration of the vehicle.
23 For an additional fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), a person eligible for

1 a physically disabled license plate shall have the option of
2 purchasing a duplicate physically disabled special license plate
3 which shall be securely attached to the front of the vehicle. The
4 original physically disabled special license plate shall be securely
5 attached to the rear of the vehicle at all times.

6 Any person who is eligible for a physically disabled license
7 plate and whose vehicle has had modifications because of the
8 physical disability of the owner or of a family member within the
9 second degree of consanguinity of the owner, may register the
10 vehicle for a flat fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). This fee
11 shall be in lieu of all other registration fees provided by the
12 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

13 9. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
15 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
16 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
17 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
18 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
19 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
20 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
21 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
22 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
23 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license

1 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
2 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
4 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
5 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
6 annulment, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

8 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
9 and is also eligible for an insignia as a physically disabled person
10 under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person
11 shall be eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that
12 also displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a
13 stylized human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the
14 disabled veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
15 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
16 the Tax Commission. The registration fee shall be Five Dollars
17 (\$5.00) for either plate style;

18 10. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates -
19 such plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has
20 been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may
21 apply for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for
22 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
23 The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00);

1 11. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
3 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
4 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
5 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
6 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
7 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
8 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
9 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
10 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
11 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
12 of one (1) ton or less. The registration fee for each plate shall
13 be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to the regular
14 plate issued and the fees charged therefor;

15 12. Indian Tribal License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for any vehicle of a native American Indian Tribal
17 Association exempted in Sections 201 through 204 of Public Law 97-
18 473 and used by the tribal association exclusively for the
19 furtherance of its tribal functions. The registration fee shall be
20 Five Dollars (\$5.00);

21 13. Personalized License Plates - such plates shall be designed
22 and issued for the following:

- 1 a. any person in any combination of numbers or letters
2 from one to a maximum of seven,
3 b. persons eligible for two or more of the military
4 decoration special license plates provided for in this
5 section. Such plates may be issued in any combination
6 of emblems. However, such plates shall only display
7 up to three emblems and shall also display any
8 combination of letters or numbers from one to a
9 maximum of three, and
10 c. motorcycles in any combination of numbers or letters
11 from one to a maximum of six.

12 The personalized license plates shall be issued on a staggered
13 system except for motorcycles.

14 On and after January 1, 1987, persons owning vehicles which are
15 twenty-one (21) years and older are qualified to submit for approval
16 by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent a vintage but expired
17 official Oklahoma license plate which is twenty-one (21) years and
18 older. Upon approval of such personalized plate, the owner shall be
19 issued the annual registration decal which the Tax Commission or
20 agent shall direct to be affixed. The Tax Commission shall
21 promulgate a rule which establishes appropriate criteria to be used
22 in the implementation of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
23 Registration Act.

1 The fee for such plate shall be Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) and
2 shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the
3 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Two Dollars (\$2.00)
4 of the personalized tag fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax
5 Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of
6 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

7 14. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall
8 be designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
9 Purple Heart military decoration and, upon the death of the
10 recipient, the spouse of the recipient. Such persons may apply for
11 a Purple Heart recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee for each plate
13 shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
14 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
15 Registration Act;

16 15. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
18 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
19 the United States as being:

- 20 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
21 7, 1941,
22 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
23 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,

1 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
2 exceed three (3) miles, and

3 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
4 States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate for
6 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
7 The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
8 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
9 Vehicle License and Registration Act.

10 The Tax Commission shall design and make available to any person
11 who is issued a Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plate a commemorative
12 Pearl Harbor decal to commemorate the fiftieth anniversary of Pearl
13 Harbor. Such decal shall include the language "Pearl Harbor 1941-
14 1991" and shall be designed to be easily attached to a license
15 plate. This decal shall be free of charge to those persons issued a
16 Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plate;

17 16. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
18 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
19 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
20 States as being:

21 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
22 of 1945,

1 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
2 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and

3 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
4 States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each vehicle
6 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
8 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
9 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
10 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
11 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
12 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
13 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
14 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
15 registration after the initial issue.

16 The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall
17 be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
18 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

19 17. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
21 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
22 the United States as being:

- 1 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
2 1944,
3 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
4 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
5 participation cannot be verified by the United States
6 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
7 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
8 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
9 the person applying for the license plate, and
10 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
11 States Armed Forces.

12 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for each
13 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
14 fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
15 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
16 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

17 18. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
19 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
20 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
21 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
22 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
23 was killed in action and that the person making the application is

1 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
2 may apply for a killed in action license plate for each vehicle with
3 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The registration
4 fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00);

5 19. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
7 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
8 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
9 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
10 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
11 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for each vehicle with
12 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The registration
13 fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00);

14 20. University or College Supporter License Plates - such
15 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
16 demonstrate support to any state-supported or private university or
17 college. The fee for such plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars
18 (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
19 required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
20 twenty-five-dollar fee shall be apportioned pursuant to Section
21 1104.1 of this title;

22 21. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
23 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
3 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
4 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
5 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
6 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
7 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
8 personalized license plates. The fee for such plate shall be
9 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other
10 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
11 Registration Act. The twenty-five-dollar fee shall be apportioned
12 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title. A dealer's license plate
13 issued pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be
14 designated an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of
15 the fee imposed by this paragraph and any other registration fees
16 required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

17 22. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
19 Distinguished Service Award, the Distinguished Flying Cross, the
20 Bronze Star military decoration or the Silver Star military
21 decoration. Such persons may apply for a military decoration
22 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
23 (1) ton or less. The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars

1 (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
2 required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

3 23. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
6 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
8 fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
9 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
10 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

11 24. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for round and square dancing. The fee for such plate shall be Five
14 Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
15 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

16 25. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
17 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
18 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
19 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
20 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
21 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
22 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
23 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to

1 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
2 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
3 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
4 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
5 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
6 department by either an identification card or letter from the
7 chief of the fire department.

8 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
9 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
10 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
11 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
12 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
13 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
14 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for
15 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
16 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
17 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
18 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
19 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
20 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

21 The fee for each plate shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and
22 shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
23 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The Twenty Dollars

1 (\$20.00) for initial registration and succeeding yearly registration
2 shall be apportioned as follows: Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) shall be
3 deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building & Memorial
4 Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and Living
5 Memorial and Five Dollars (\$5.00) to the Tax Commission;

6 26. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for any currently employed or retired municipal police
8 officer. Police officers may apply for police officer plates for
9 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of
10 employment by or retirement from a municipal police department by
11 either an identification card or letter from the chief of the police
12 department or the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement Board.
13 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
14 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
15 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
16 designed in consultation with municipal police departments of this
17 state.

18 The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall
19 be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
20 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

21 27. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
23 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
2 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
3 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
4 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
5 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
6 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
11 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
12 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
13 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
14 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
15 bottom of the license plate shall be the words "WORLD WAR II".
16 However, the plates may be issued to any person in any combination
17 of numbers and letters with up to three on each side of the insignia
18 or emblem as for personalized license plates.

19 The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall
20 be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
21 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. If the plate is
22 issued in any combination of numbers and letters with up to three on
23 each side of the insignia or emblem as for personalized license

1 plates, the fee for each plate shall be Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) and
2 shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
3 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

4 The Tax Commission shall design and make available to any person
5 who is issued a World War II Veteran License Plate a commemorative
6 World War II decal to commemorate the fiftieth anniversary of the
7 end of World War II. The decal shall include the language "World
8 War II 50th Anniversary" and shall be designed to be easily attached
9 to a license plate. This decal shall be free of charge to those
10 persons issued a World War II Veteran License Plate;

11 28. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
13 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
14 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
15 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
16 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
17 September 1, 1950, to April 27, 1954. The former members may apply
18 for a Korean War Veteran license plate for vehicles with a rated
19 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

20 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
21 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
22 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
23 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or

1 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
2 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
3 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
4 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
5 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA". However, the
6 plates may be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
7 letters with up to three on each side of the insignia or emblem as
8 for personalized license plates.

9 The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall
10 be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
11 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. If the plate is
12 issued in any combination of numbers and letters with up to three on
13 each side of the insignia or emblem as for personalized license
14 plates, the fee for each plate shall be Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) and
15 shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
16 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

17 29. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
19 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
20 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
21 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
22 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
23 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may

1 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
2 plates. The fee for the plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)
3 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by
4 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Motor license
5 agents shall have the option of stocking an inventory of numbered
6 Wildlife Conservation License Plates, as well as stocking
7 applications for personalized Wildlife Conservation License Plates.
8 In addition to the amounts authorized to be retained by motor
9 license agents pursuant to the provisions of Section 1141.1 of this
10 title, motor license agents shall retain an additional Three Dollars
11 (\$3.00) for each original Wildlife Conservation License Plate issued
12 and for each application submitted by mail that carries the agent's
13 code and for which a Wildlife Conservation License Plate is issued.
14 The three-dollar fee to be retained by the motor license agent
15 pursuant to this paragraph shall not be included in the maximum sum
16 that may be retained by motor license agents as compensation
17 pursuant to the provisions of Section 1143 of this title. For the
18 first year such plate is issued, Seventeen Dollars (\$17.00) of the
19 twenty-five-dollar fee shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D
20 of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. After the
21 first year such plate is issued, Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the
22 twenty-five-dollar fee shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D
23 of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 30. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
3 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
4 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
5 be produced upon application. The fee for the plate shall be
6 Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) and shall be in addition to the regular
7 plate issued to the elected municipal official and the fees charged
8 therefor;

9 31. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
12 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
13 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the prevention of child abuse. The fee for the plate shall be
15 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other
16 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
17 Registration Act. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the twenty-five-dollar
18 fee shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

19 32. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
20 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
21 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
22 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP.
23 The fee for the plate shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and shall be

1 in addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
2 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

3 33. National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
5 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
6 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
7 Association. The fee for the plate shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
8 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by
9 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

10 34. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
12 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
13 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
14 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
15 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
16 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
17 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
18 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
19 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
20 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
21 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
22 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
23 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue. The fee

1 for such plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
2 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
3 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

4 35. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
5 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
6 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
7 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
8 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
9 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
10 Olympic Committee logo. The fee for such plate shall be Twenty-
11 eight Dollars (\$28.00) and shall be in addition to all other
12 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
13 Registration Act. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
14 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
15 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
16 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
17 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
18 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
19 issued. Motor license agents shall have the option of stocking an
20 inventory of preprinted United States Olympic Committee Supporter
21 License Plates, as well as stocking applications for personalized
22 United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates. In
23 addition to the amounts authorized to be retained by motor license

1 agents pursuant to the provisions of Section 1141.1 of this title,
2 motor license agents shall retain an additional Three Dollars
3 (\$3.00) for each United States Olympic Committee Supporter License
4 Plate issued and for each application submitted by mail that carries
5 the agent's code and for which a United States Olympic Committee
6 Supporter License Plate is issued. The three-dollar fee to be
7 retained by the motor license agent pursuant to this paragraph shall
8 not be included in the maximum sum that may be retained by motor
9 license agents as compensation pursuant to the provisions of Section
10 1143 of this title;

11 36. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
13 Oklahoma history. The fee for such plate shall be Twenty Dollars
14 (\$20.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
15 required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
16 Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the twenty-dollar fee shall be deposited
17 to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving Fund to be used for
18 educational purposes;

19 37. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
21 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
22 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
23 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

1 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
2 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
3 Academy. The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and
4 shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
5 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

6 38. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
8 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
9 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
10 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
11 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
12 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
13 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
15 contain the Masonic emblem. The fee for each plate shall be Five
16 Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
17 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

18 39. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
20 Road".

21 The fee for the plate shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and shall
22 be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
23 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Fifteen Dollars

1 (\$15.00) of the twenty-dollar fee shall be apportioned to the
2 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department Revolving Fund to be
3 distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma;

4 40. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
6 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
7 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. The fee for
8 the plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in
9 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
10 Vehicle License and Registration Act. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of
11 the twenty-five-dollar fee shall be deposited in the Heart of the
12 Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in Section 2282 of Title
13 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 41. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
15 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
16 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
17 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Association. The fee for such
19 plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all
20 other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
21 Registration Act;

22 42. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children
23 License Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate

1 support for Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and
2 shall be issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a
3 Shriner's Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed
4 in consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
5 contain the Shriner's emblem. The fee for the plate shall be Five
6 Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
7 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

8 43. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
10 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
11 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
12 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
13 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
14 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
15 technicians. The fee for the plate shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
16 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by
17 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Fifteen Dollars
18 (\$15.00) of the twenty-dollar fee shall be apportioned to the county
19 of residence of the person purchasing the plates to be equally
20 apportioned by the county to the city and county volunteer fire
21 departments in the county;

22 44. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of

1 breast cancer in this state. The plate shall contain the legend
2 "Fight Breast Cancer". The fee for the plate shall be Twenty-five
3 Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
4 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
5 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the twenty-five-dollar fee shall be
6 apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act Revolving Fund;

7 45. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
8 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
9 ballooning in this state. The fee for such plate shall be Twenty-
10 five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other
11 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
12 Registration Act;

13 46. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
14 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
15 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
16 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
17 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
18 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
19 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization. The
20 fee for the plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
21 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
22 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

1 47. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
3 member of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for
4 an Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
5 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
6 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
7 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
8 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
9 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
10 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem. The fee for
11 each license plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
12 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
13 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

14 48. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
16 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
17 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
18 Centre. The fee for the plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)
19 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by
20 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Twenty Dollars
21 (\$20.00) of the twenty-five-dollar fee shall be apportioned to the
22 Attorney General's Revolving Fund for the Office of the Attorney
23 General, which is hereby directed to use such funds to contract with

1 a statewide nonprofit organization to provide services to crime
2 victims;

3 49. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
5 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
6 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
7 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
8 of one (1) ton or less. The fee for each plate shall be Five
9 Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
10 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

11 50. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
13 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
14 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
15 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee for
16 each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to
17 all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
18 and Registration Act;

19 51. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
21 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
22 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus

1 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
2 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
3 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
4 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
5 Columbus emblem. The fee for each license plate shall be Five
6 Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
7 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

8 52. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
11 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
12 Safe Kids Association. The fee for the plate shall be Twenty-five
13 Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
14 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
15 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the twenty-five-dollar fee shall be
16 deposited in the Children's Hospital - Oklahoma Safe Kids
17 Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Oklahoma Safe
18 Kids Association program;

19 53. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
20 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
21 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
22 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. The fee for such plate
23 shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other

1 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
2 Registration Act;

3 54. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
5 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
6 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
7 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
8 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol.
9 The fee for the plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
10 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
11 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

12 55. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
13 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
14 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
15 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
16 the Ninety-Nines. The fee for such plate shall be Five Dollars
17 (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
18 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

19 56. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
20 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
21 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
22 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees. The fee
23 for such plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in

1 addition to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma
2 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

3 57. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
5 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
6 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
7 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
8 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
9 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
10 less. The fee for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and
11 shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
12 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

13 58. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
15 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
16 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
17 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee for each plate shall be
19 Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
20 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
21 Registration Act;

22 59. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying

1 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
2 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed
3 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited. The fee for such plate shall
4 be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
5 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
6 Registration Act;

7 60. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
9 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
10 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
11 consultation with Kiwanis International. The fee for such plate
12 shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
13 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
14 Registration Act;

15 61. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
17 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
18 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
19 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
20 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
21 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
22 Accountants. The fee for each license plate shall be Five Dollars

1 (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
2 required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

3 62. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
5 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
6 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
7 be designed in consultation with the ICPC. The fee for such plates
8 shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
9 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
10 Registration Act;

11 63. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
12 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
13 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
15 to any person as for personalized license plates. The fee for such
16 plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition
17 to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle
18 License and Registration Act. Motor license agents shall have the
19 option of stocking an inventory of numbered Four-H Club License
20 Plates, as well as stocking applications for personalized Four-H
21 Club License Plates. In addition to the amounts authorized to be
22 retained by motor license agents pursuant to the provisions of
23 Section 1141.1 of this title, motor license agents shall retain an

1 additional Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each original Four-H Club
2 License Plate issued and for each application submitted by mail that
3 carries the agent's code and for which a Four-H Club License Plate
4 is issued. The three-dollar fee to be retained by the motor license
5 agent pursuant to this paragraph shall not be included in the
6 maximum sum that may be retained by motor license agents as
7 compensation pursuant to the provisions of Section 1143 of this
8 title. For the first year such plate is issued, Seventeen Dollars
9 (\$17.00) of the twenty-five-dollar fee shall be apportioned to the
10 OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
11 Section 1104.4 of this title. After the first year such plate is
12 issued, Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the twenty-five-dollar fee shall
13 be apportioned to such fund;

14 64. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
15 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
16 Commission, by the State Department of Agriculture in consultation
17 with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the Classroom
19 Education Program. The fee for such plate shall be Twenty-five
20 Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
21 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
22 The fee shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.3 of this
23 title;

1 65. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
3 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. The fee
6 for such plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in
7 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
8 Vehicle License and Registration Act. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of
9 the twenty-five-dollar fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
10 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission Revolving
11 Fund created in Section 98.5 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 66. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
14 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
15 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
16 demonstrate support for education in this state. The fee for such
17 plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition
18 to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle
19 License and Registration Act. Two Dollars (\$2.00) of the twenty-
20 five-dollar fee shall be deposited into the Oklahoma Tax Commission
21 Reimbursement Fund. The remaining Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00)
22 shall be apportioned as follows:

- 1 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
2 Reform Revolving Fund,
3 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
4 Education Revolving Fund,
5 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
6 Vocational-Technical Fund, and
7 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
8 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
9 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
10 Oklahoma Statutes. However, when the Teachers'
11 Retirement Benefit Fund attains a seventy percent
12 (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
13 valuation as required by law, Twenty-three Dollars
14 (\$23.00) of the fee shall be apportioned equally
15 pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
16 paragraph;

17 67. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
18 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
19 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
20 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
21 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
22 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
23 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in

1 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
2 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
3 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
4 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
5 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
6 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
7 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
8 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
9 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. The fee for each
10 plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition
11 to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle
12 License and Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as
13 follows: Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) shall be deposited into the Law
14 Enforcement Retirement Fund, and Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall be
15 deposited to the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund;

16 68. Hearing Impaired License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for persons who are hearing impaired. Such persons may
18 apply for a hearing-impaired license plate for each vehicle with a
19 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon the presentment
20 of an application on a form furnished by the Tax Commission and
21 certified by a physician holding a valid license to practice
22 pursuant to the licensing provisions of Title 59 of the Oklahoma
23 Statutes, attesting that the person is hearing impaired. The

1 license plate shall be designed so that such persons may be readily
2 identified as being hearing impaired. There shall be no additional
3 fee for the plate, but all other registration fees provided by the
4 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act shall apply;

5 69. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
7 support for the state civil emergency management system. The
8 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Department
9 of Civil Emergency Management. The fee for such plate shall be Five
10 Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
11 fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

12 70. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
14 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
15 United States Secretary of Defense. The fee for such plate shall be
16 Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
17 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
18 Registration Act;

19 71. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
22 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
23 Conservation Corps. The fee for such plate shall be Five Dollars

1 (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
2 required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

3 72. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
4 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
5 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
6 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
7 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
8 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
9 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
11 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem. The fee
12 for each plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
13 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
14 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

15 73. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
17 by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and issued to any
18 resident of this state who is a member of the Benevolent Protective
19 Order of Elks. The fee for such plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00)
20 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by
21 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

22 74. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
2 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
3 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
4 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
5 The fee for such plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and
6 shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
7 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The Tax Commission
8 shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing
9 agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing fees
10 which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America logo
11 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
12 the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
13 for each license plate issued;

14 75. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
16 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
17 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
18 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
19 shall contain the official Humane Society logo. The fee for such
20 plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all
21 other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
22 Registration Act;

1 76. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
3 Tax Commission, by the State Department of Agriculture in
4 consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state that develop
5 and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and beautification,
6 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of such
7 programs. The fee for such plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars
8 (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
9 required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
10 fee shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5 of this
11 title;

12 77. Oklahoma Mustang Club - such plates shall be designed,
13 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, by the
14 Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this state who
15 is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons may apply
16 for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon presentment of proof
17 of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club. The plates shall be
18 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
19 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The
20 fee for such plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in
21 addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma
22 Vehicle License and Registration Act;

1 78. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
5 state parks system. The fee for such plate shall be Twenty-five
6 Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration
7 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
8 Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the twenty-five-dollar fee shall be
9 deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department
10 Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and may only be
11 expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

12 79. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
14 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
15 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with American Business Clubs. The fee for such plate
17 shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
18 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
19 Registration Act;

20 80. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
23 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as

1 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
2 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee for each plate shall be
4 Five Dollars (\$5.00) and shall be in addition to all other
5 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
6 Registration Act;

7 81. Respect Life - Support Adoption License Plates - such
8 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 of pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
10 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
11 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
12 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
13 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
14 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
15 Services. The fee for the plate shall be Twenty-five Dollars
16 (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
17 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
18 twenty-five-dollar fee derived from the sale of such plates shall be
19 deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for
20 and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
21 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
22 specifically for created families;

1 82. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
3 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
4 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
5 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
6 Oklahoma. The fee for such plate shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) and
7 shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by the
8 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

9 83. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
10 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
11 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
12 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
13 with unplanned pregnancies. The fee for the plate shall be Twenty-
14 five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other
15 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
16 Registration Act. Five Dollars (\$5.00) of the twenty-five dollar
17 fee shall be deposited into the Oklahoma Tax Commission
18 Reimbursement Fund. The remaining Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) derived
19 from the sale of such plates shall be deposited in the Choose Life
20 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
21 this title;

22 84. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for

1 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
2 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
3 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. The fee for such plate shall be
4 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and shall be in addition to all other
5 registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
6 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as provided in
7 Section 1104.7 of this title; and

8 85. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
9 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
10 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
11 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
12 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
13 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
14 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
15 of Lions Clubs. The fee for such plate shall be Fifteen Dollars
16 (\$15.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
17 required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
18 Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
19 agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation. The licensing
20 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Lions Service
21 Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each license
22 plate issued.

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this title,
2 Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each special tag fee shall be deposited to
3 the Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
4 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

5 Use of any vehicle possessing a special license plate for any
6 purpose not specified in this section shall be grounds for
7 revocation of the special license plate and registration
8 certificate.

9 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1115.2 of Title 47, unless there
11 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 A. The Legislature hereby occupies and preempts the entire
13 field of legislation in this state touching in any way the
14 enforcement of registration and licensing of automobiles to the
15 complete exclusion of any order, ordinance, or regulation by any
16 municipality or other political subdivision of this state. Any
17 existing or future orders, ordinances, or regulations in this field,
18 except as provided for in subsection B of this section, are null and
19 void.

20 B. Nothing contained in this section shall prohibit any order,
21 ordinance, or regulation of any municipality from enacting and
22 enforcing laws prohibiting and penalizing conduct prohibited by
23 Sections 1101 through 1151.1 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes,

1 but the provisions of such order, ordinance, or regulation by a
2 municipality shall not be more stringent than those of the Oklahoma
3 Vehicle License and Registration Act.

4 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
