COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2259 - By: WILT

[crimes and punishments - punishments for subsequent

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 888, as
amended by Section 4, Chapter 455, O.S.L. 2002 (21 O.S. Supp. 2003,
Section 888), is amended to read as follows:

Section 888. A. Any person who forces another person to engage
in the detestable and abominable crime against nature, pursuant to
Section 886 of this title, upon conviction, is guilty of a felony
punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a period of
not more than twenty (20) years, except as provided in Section 3
51.1a of this ~~act~~ title. Any person convicted of a second violation
of this section, where the victim of the second offense is a person
under sixteen (16) years of age, shall not be eligible for
probation, suspended or deferred sentence.

B. The crime of forcible sodomy shall include:

- 1 1. Sodomy committed by a person over eighteen (18) years of age
2 upon a person under sixteen (16) years of age; or
- 3 2. Sodomy committed upon a person incapable through mental
4 illness or any unsoundness of mind of giving legal consent
5 regardless of the age of the person committing the crime; or
- 6 3. Sodomy accomplished with any person by means of force,
7 violence, or threats of force or violence accompanied by apparent
8 power of execution regardless of the age of the victim or the person
9 committing the crime; or
- 10 4. Sodomy committed by a state, county, municipal or political
11 subdivision employee or a contractor or an employee of a contractor
12 of the state, a county, a municipality or political subdivision of
13 this state upon a person who is under the legal custody, supervision
14 or authority of a state agency, a county, a municipality or a
15 political subdivision of this state.

16 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1115, as
17 amended by Section 5, Chapter 455, O.S.L. 2002 (21 O.S. Supp. 2003,
18 Section 1115), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1115. Rape in the first degree is a felony punishable
20 by death or imprisonment in the State Penitentiary, for a term of
21 not less than five (5) years nor more than life, except as provided
22 in Section ~~3~~ 51.1a of this act ~~, in the discretion of the jury, or~~
23 ~~in case the jury fails or refuses to fix the punishment then the~~

1 ~~same shall be pronounced by the court~~ title. Any person convicted
2 of a subsequent violation of subsection A of Section 1114 of this
3 title shall not be eligible for any form of probation.

4 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1123, as
5 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 159, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp.
6 2003, Section 1123), is amended to read as follows:

7 Section 1123. A. It is a felony for any person to knowingly
8 and intentionally:

- 9 1. Make any oral, written or electronically or computer-
10 generated lewd or indecent proposal to any child under sixteen (16)
11 years of age, or other individual the person believes to be a child
12 under sixteen (16) years of age, for the child to have unlawful
13 sexual relations or sexual intercourse with any person; or
- 14 2. Look upon, touch, maul, or feel the body or private parts of
15 any child under sixteen (16) years of age in any lewd or lascivious
16 manner by any acts against public decency and morality, as defined
17 by law; or
- 18 3. Ask, invite, entice, or persuade any child under sixteen
19 (16) years of age, or other individual the person believes to be a
20 child under sixteen (16) years of age, to go alone with any person
21 to a secluded, remote, or secret place, with the unlawful and
22 willful intent and purpose then and there to commit any crime

1 against public decency and morality, as defined by law, with the
2 child; or

3 4. In any manner lewdly or lasciviously look upon, touch, maul,
4 or feel the body or private parts of any child under sixteen (16)
5 years of age in any indecent manner or in any manner relating to
6 sexual matters or sexual interest; or

7 5. In a lewd and lascivious manner and for the purpose of
8 sexual gratification:

- 9 a. urinate or defecate upon a child under sixteen (16)
10 years of age,
11 b. ejaculate upon or in the presence of a child,
12 c. cause, expose, force or require a child to look upon
13 the body or private parts of another person,
14 d. force or require any child under sixteen (16) years of
15 age or other individual the person believes to be a
16 child under sixteen (16) years of age, to view any
17 obscene materials, child pornography or materials
18 deemed harmful to minors as such terms are defined by
19 Sections 1024.1 and 1040.75 of this title,
20 e. cause, expose, force or require a child to look upon
21 sexual acts performed in the presence of the child, or
22 f. force or require a child to touch or feel the body or
23 private parts of said child or another person.

1 Any person convicted of any violation of subsection A of this
2 section shall be punished by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary
3 for not less than one (1) year nor more than twenty (20) years. The
4 provisions of this section shall not apply unless the accused is at
5 least three (3) years older than the victim. Any person convicted
6 of a ~~second or~~ subsequent violation of subsection A of this section
7 shall be guilty of a felony punishable as provided in ~~this~~
8 ~~subsection~~ Section 51.1a of this title and shall not be eligible for
9 probation, suspended or deferred sentence. ~~Any person convicted of~~
10 ~~a third or subsequent violation of subsection A of this section~~
11 ~~shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the State~~
12 ~~Penitentiary for a term of life or life without parole, in the~~
13 ~~discretion of the jury, or in case the jury fails or refuses to fix~~
14 ~~punishment then the same shall be pronounced by the court. Any~~
15 ~~person convicted of a violation of this subsection after having been~~
16 ~~twice convicted of a violation of subsection A of Section 1114 of~~
17 ~~this title, Section 888 of this title, sexual abuse of a child~~
18 ~~pursuant to Section 7115 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or of~~
19 ~~any attempt to commit any of these offenses or any combination of~~
20 ~~convictions pursuant to these sections shall be punished by~~
21 ~~imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of life or life~~
22 ~~without parole.~~

1 B. No person shall commit sexual battery on any other person.
2 "Sexual battery" shall mean the intentional touching, mauling or
3 feeling of the body or private parts of any person sixteen (16)
4 years of age or older, in a lewd and lascivious manner and without
5 the consent of that person or when committed by a state, county,
6 municipal or political subdivision employee or a contractor or an
7 employee of a contractor of the state, a county, a municipality or
8 political subdivision of this state upon a person who is under the
9 legal custody, supervision or authority of a state agency, a county,
10 a municipality or a political subdivision of this state.

11 C. Any person convicted of any violation of ~~this~~ subsection B
12 of this section shall be deemed guilty of a felony and shall be
13 punished by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for not more than
14 five (5) years.

15 D. The fact that an undercover operative or law enforcement
16 officer was involved in the detection and investigation of an
17 offense pursuant to this section shall not constitute a defense to a
18 prosecution under this section.

19 SECTION 4. REPEALER 21 O.S. 2001, Sections 888 and 1115,
20 as amended by Sections 9 and 10, Chapter 460, O.S.L. 2002 (21 O.S.
21 Supp. 2003, Sections 888 and 1115), and 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1123,
22 as amended by Section 6, Chapter 455, O.S.L. 2002 (21 O.S. Supp.
23 2003, Section 1123), are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
