SENATE BILL NO. 1155 - By: WILKERSON of the Senate and BRADDOCK of the House.

[ Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation - salaries - pay movement mechanisms - effective date ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 150.6a, is amended to read as follows:

Section 150.6a A. Effective ~~October 1, 2000~~ November 1, 2004, the annual salaries for the Deputy Director, and the positions within the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as set out in this section, shall be in accordance and conformity with the following salary schedule, exclusive of longevity pay as authorized by Section 840-2.18 of ~~Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title:

1. Deputy Director:

The salary of the Deputy Director shall be ninety-five percent (95%) of that received by the Director;

2. Division Director:

1           The salary of a Division Director shall  
2           be ninety percent (90%) of that received  
3           by the Director;

4        3. Agent I (OSBI), Criminalist I:  
5           Minimum \$33,500.00, Mid-point  
6           \$41,875.00, Maximum \$50,250.00

7        4. Agent II (OSBI), Criminalist II:  
8           Minimum \$39,250.00, Mid-point  
9           \$49,062.00, Maximum \$58,875.00

10       5. ~~Special~~ Agent III (OSBI), ~~Senior~~ Criminalist III:  
11           Minimum \$46,250.00, Mid-point  
12           \$57,812.00, Maximum \$69,375.00

13       6. Agent/~~Deputy Inspector~~ IV (OSBI),  
14           Criminalist ~~Supervisor~~ IV:  
15           Minimum \$51,000.00, Mid-point  
16           \$63,750.00, Maximum \$76,500.00

17       7. Agent/~~Inspector~~ V (OSBI), Criminalist  
18           ~~Administrator~~ V:  
19           Minimum \$56,000.00, Mid-point  
20           \$70,000.00, Maximum \$84,000.00

21       B. ~~The annual increases provided for in this section shall be~~  
22 ~~subject to the availability of funds within the budget of the~~  
23 ~~Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation~~ Effective November 1, 2004,

1 agents and criminalists currently employed by the Oklahoma State  
2 Bureau of Investigation at that time shall receive a five percent  
3 (5%) increase above the minimum pay established for the employee's  
4 particular pay band as established in this act if adequate funding  
5 is available. Positions allocated to the agent and criminalist job  
6 families may receive additional compensation through the use of pay  
7 mechanisms provided for in the Oklahoma Personnel Act and the Merit  
8 System of Personnel Administration Rules.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
