Senate Bill No. 280

As Amended

SENATE BILL NO. 280 - By: REYNOLDS of the Senate and COLEMAN of the House.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating certain portion of State Highway 77H as the "Pearl Harbor/USS Oklahoma Memorial Highway"; requiring the Department of Transportation to cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1648 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 77H, from where it intersects with State Highway 9 in Cleveland County, north to where it intersects with Interstate Highway 240 in Oklahoma County, shall be designated as the "Pearl Harbor/USS Oklahoma Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing such name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
