SENATE BILL NO. 336 - By: COATES of the Senate and CALVEY of the House.

[labor - Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety Act - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2001, Section 141.16, is amended to read as follows:

Section 141.16 A. Schedule of Fees

1. Annual certificate of operation fee

- a. with manway state inspector \$ 50.00
- b. without manway state inspector \$ 25.00
- c. any size special - or owner/user inspector \$ 25.00

Note: Only one certificate of operation fee per year may be charged; except an additional fee equal to the certificate of operation fee may be charged for witnessing a hydrostatic test required after repairs and a fee equal to the certificate of operation fee may be charged when the pressure retaining item is not prepared and ready, pursuant to OAC 380:25-7-2, at the time of a scheduled inspection.

14 B. Exemptions. All institutions owned or operated by the State
15 of Oklahoma or its agencies or by any county, municipality or school
16 district, and such institutions or agencies, and all owners or users
17 of boilers or pressure vessels of historical significance as
18 specified in subsection D of Section 141.5 of this title are exempt
19 from the payment of any fees provided for herein.

20 C. Disposition of fees. The Commissioner of Labor shall
21 account for and transfer all fees, except for shop review fees,
22 licensing fees, and authorized inspector service fees so received to
23 the State Treasury to the credit of the General Revenue Fund

1 together with a detailed report of same. Shop review fees,
2 licensing fees, and authorized inspector services fees shall be
3 deposited to the Department of Labor Revolving Fund created pursuant
4 to Section 141.19 of this title. The shop review fees, licensing
5 fees, and authorized inspector services fees shall be used for
6 conducting shop reviews, authorized inspector services and for
7 administrative costs pertaining to shop reviews, licensing, and
8 authorized inspector services.

9 D. All fees shall be paid directly to the Department of Labor.
