COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 350 - By: PRUITT of the Senate and PETERSON of the House.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating a portion of the south loop of the Creek Turnpike as "Liberty Memorial Parkway"; directing the Oklahoma Transportation Authority to place suitable permanent markers on certain turnpike; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The south loop of the Creek Turnpike where it intersects with U.S. Highway 64 in Tulsa County, southeast to where it intersects with the Muskogee Turnpike in Wagoner County, shall be designated as "Liberty Memorial Parkway". The Oklahoma Transportation Authority shall place suitable permanent markers on the turnpike bearing such name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
