SENATE BILL NO. 847 - By: HELTON of the Senate and ROAN of the House.

[Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training - CLEET Cafeteria Revolving Fund - codification - effective date - emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3311.8 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training to be designated the "CLEET Cafeteria Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training from cafeteria food sales. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training for the purpose of operating a cafeteria. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3311.9 of Title 70, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 There is hereby created a petty cash fund not to exceed Two
5 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for the Council on Law Enforcement
6 Education and Training to be used as a cash drawer change fund in
7 the operation of a cafeteria.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2004.

9 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
