5 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 50 - By: LAWLER of the Senate and TYLER
6 of the House.

7 A Joint Resolution designating the month of May of each year
8 as "Motorcycle Safety Month" in the State of Oklahoma;
9 providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

10 WHEREAS, motorcycles are an important means of transportation
11 and a source of recreation; and

12 WHEREAS, motorcycles have been used in local and national
13 government activities in peacetime and wartime; and

14 WHEREAS, it is important for motorcyclists to develop sound
15 riding skills and safety habits; and

16 WHEREAS, all motorist should be aware of their obligation to
17 responsibly and safely share the roads and streets with
18 motorcyclists; and

19 WHEREAS, due to the increased number of motorcycles on the road,
20 it is appropriate to set aside a time to promote motorcycle safety
21 awareness.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
23 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 90.15 of Title 25, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The month of May of each year is hereby designated as
5 "Motorcycle Safety Month" in the State of Oklahoma.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
