

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Sections 4661, 4663, 4666, 4667 and 4668, which relate to higher education institutions in Tulsa; authorizing the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to develop and implement certain policies for the offering of programs in Tulsa County; deleting certain restrictions on the number of degree programs offered by certain institutions; directing the Regents to develop a plan for the relocation of the Tulsa Community College Metro campus; requiring certain comparisons; stating intent of the Legislature; deleting certain intent statements; deleting certain restrictions on the duplication of undergraduate degree programs offered by Langston University in Tulsa; directing the Regents to develop a plan to relocate Langston University in Tulsa; stating certain criteria for the new location; deleting certain restrictions on the duplication of undergraduate degree programs offered by Northeastern State University in Tulsa; establishing a branch institution of the University of Oklahoma in Tulsa; requiring the Regents to submit a report recommending a local governing board for the University of Oklahoma/Tulsa; repealing 70 O.S. 2001, Section 4665, which relates to restrictions on duplication of courses offered by Tulsa Community College; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
