

An Act relating to schools; making school district board of education members subject to recall from their office; listing the bases for recall; providing for recall by election; requiring circulation of a recall petition; establishing number of signatures needed on petition for recall election; prohibiting recall petition for certain period at the beginning of a term of office; requiring petition to contain a general statement outlining basis of recall; providing for filing of petition; providing for filing of protests to the recall petition; requiring ruling by district court within certain time period; providing procedure to fill vacancy upon registration of the member; directing secretary of the county election board to certify petition and hold recall election; directing the Superintendent of Public Instruction to schedule recall election; requiring certain statement on ballots; allowing member to prepare a statement to appear on the ballot; directing member to continue performing duties until results of the election are declared; providing for application of certain laws; providing for immediate vacancy and procedure for filling vacancy; providing for certification of election; directing certain school districts to submit an annual economically disadvantaged pupil weight report; stating deadline for first report; describing contents of the report; requiring the State Board of Education to withhold State Aid funds for failure to submit a report; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
