

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 3311, as last amended by Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1838 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training; increasing number of members of the council; providing for Governor to appoint one member; providing for adoption of certain certified canines; prohibiting certain persons previously certified and evaluated from being reevaluated following retirement or break in service as a peace officer; modifying hours required for certification as full-time officer; modifying time period for obtaining certification; requiring certain tribal law enforcement agency to report the commissioning, resignation, or termination of police or peace officers within certain time; providing for disqualification for failure to comply; modifying offenses subject to disciplinary action; modifying provisions allowing for suspension of certification; authorizing issuance of peace officer certification to tribal officers meeting certain qualifications; repealing 70 O.S. 2001, Section 3311, as last amended by Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2347 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training; repealing 70 O.S. 2001, Section 3311, as last amended by Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1208 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training; and declaring an emergency.
