

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 12 O.S. 2001, Section 2609, as amended by Section 48, Chapter 468, O.S.L. 2002 (12 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 2609), which relates to credibility of a witness; providing an exception to certain evidence of conviction; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 175, which relates to accessory to a felony; adding punishment for accessory to murder in the second degree; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 741, which relates to kidnapping; making gender neutral; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1051, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 202, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 1051), which relates to lotteries; including certain tax exempt organizations; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1172, which relates to illegal use of telephone; expanding provision to other electronic communication; prohibiting hindering emergency calls; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1451, as amended by Section 12, Chapter 460, O.S.L. 2002 (21 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 1451), which relates to embezzlement; setting certain penalty; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1767.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 168, O.S.L. 2003 (21 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 1767.1), which relates to bombing; modifying element of crime; amending 22 O.S. 303, which relates to verification of information; removing requirement for verification on information; providing procedures and restrictions for detaining material witness without warrant; amending 22 O.S. 2001, Section 979a, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 319, O.S.L. 2003 (22 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 979a), which relates to jail costs; changing percentage paid to municipal and district attorney offices; amending 22 O.S. 2001, Section 991c, as amended by Section 20, Chapter 460, O.S.L. 2002 (22 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 991c), which relates to deferred judgment; limiting deferred judgments; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-904, which relates to personal injury accident; including certain offenses to certain enhancement of penalty; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Section 2-401, as last amended by Section 5 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2176 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to controlled dangerous substances; removing certain exception to certain assessment; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 150.23, which relates to custody and possession of firearm upon death or retirement of certain officers; adding district attorney investigator; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 913, as last amended by Section 101 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2725 of the 2nd Session of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to public employees; construing furloughs of employees of certain agency; providing for codification; providing effective dates; and declaring an emergency.
