AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; requiring approval of certain law enforcement agencies for use of certain items in advertisements; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3115 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No person, organization, agency, or business entity may use the insignia, badge design, or patch design of any law enforcement agency of this state for the purposes of an advertisement without first obtaining approval of the director or the chief administrative officer of the law enforcement agency.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
