HOUSE BILL HB1359

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tobacco; requiring the Attorney General to provide certain notice regarding changes in the Master Settlement Agreement; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 600.24 of Title 37, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Attorney General shall provide written notice to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate of any changes to the Master Settlement Agreement defined in Section 600.22 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes that would cause the Legislature to amend Sections 600.21 through 600.23 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes in order to protect the interests of the State of Oklahoma in the Master Settlement Agreement.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
