HOUSE BILL HB1392

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2001, Section 3-101, which relates to days on which elections are held; modifying when certain special elections may be held; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 3-101, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3-101. A. No election required to be conducted by any county election board shall be scheduled for a day other than Tuesday.

B. Except as otherwise provided by law, no special election shall be held by any county, school district, technology center school district, municipality or other entity authorized to call elections except on the second Tuesday of ~~January, February, May, June, July, August, September, October,~~ November and December and the first Tuesday in March and April in odd-numbered years and the ~~second Tuesday of January, February, March, May, June and December, the first Tuesday in April, the fourth Tuesday in August, the third Tuesday in September~~ and the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of any even-numbered year.

C. In the event that a regular or special election date occurs on an official state holiday, the election shall be scheduled for the next following Tuesday.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
