AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to appropriations; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce; stating purpose related to recommendation of Oklahoma Military Base Closure Prevention Task Force; allocating funds; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of One Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000.00) pursuant to the recommendations of the Oklahoma Military Base Closure Prevention Task Force to assist communities with strategic planning in order to prevent a military base closure or a military base realignment which would be detrimental to one of the affected communities. The appropriations shall be allocated as follows:

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
