AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to labor; providing restrictions on employee vehicle searches; prohibiting contracts or agreements with certain entities; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 200 of Title 40, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Employers of this state that conduct vehicle searches of its employees shall conduct such search on the property of the employer only. Searches that are conducted on property not owned by the employer shall require a search warrant issued according to law.

B. Employers that conduct vehicle searches shall not contract or make agreements with individuals, agencies, or firms that offer investigative services. All vehicle searches shall be conducted by the employer.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
