AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to education; making appropriations to the State Board of Education; stating purpose; expressing legislative intent; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 2. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that the appropriation made by this act represent \_\_\_\_\_ percent (0.0%) of total funds available for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, as outlined in Appendix A-1 of the document entitled "State Board of Equalization Proposed FY-2004 Revenue Certification" which was presented to the State Board of Equalization on December 20, 2002.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
