AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to county and county officers; providing for reimbursement and costs of sheriffs for certain activities; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 180.43A of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any travel, other than in-county driving, by a sheriff or a designated employee of the sheriff whereby a service is performed for a state agency shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act by the board of county commissioners. The state agency receiving the service shall be responsible for paying any additional cost incurred by the performing county such as overtime pay.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
