HOUSE BILL HB1788

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 2001, Section 3-502, which relates to filing warrants with the county clerk; requiring the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission to include certain employer information to be filed with county clerk; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2001, Section 3-502, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3-502. FILING WARRANT WITH COUNTY CLERK. A. The Commission may also file a copy of its warrant with the county clerk of the county or counties in which the employer has property and thereupon the county clerk shall index the warrant in the same manner as judgments using the name of the delinquent employer named in the warrant, a short name for the contribution, or tax imposed, and the amount of the contributions, interest, penalty and fees for which the warrant was issued, and the date upon which the copy was filed, and shall index the warrant against the real property described therein, if any is described. If the county clerk charges a fee for the filing of the warrant, the Commission may add the amount of the fee to the indebtedness owing by the delinquent employer named in the warrant.

B. If the Commission elects to file a copy of the warrant with the county clerk, the Commission shall also furnish the social security number of the delinquent employer with the copy of the warrant to be filed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
