HOUSE BILL HB1857:

Brannon

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public retirement systems; authorizing cost-of-living increases; authorizing increases for certain persons receiving benefits from Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma and Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-116.19 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma as of June 30, 2003, who continues to receive benefits on or after July 1, 2004, shall receive a two percent (2%) increase in said benefits on July 1, 2004.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 930.8 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System as of June 30, 2003, who continues to receive benefits on or after July 1, 2004, shall receive a two percent (2%) increase in said benefits on July 1, 2004.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2004.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
