AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending Section 1, Chapter 396, O.S.L. 2003 (47 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 1132.5); clarifying language; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 396, O.S.L. 2003 (47 O.S. Supp. 2003, Section 1132.5), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1132.5 A. In addition to any other vehicle registration fees specified by law, beginning September 1, 2003, through August 30, 2005, there is levied and there shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax Commission a fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) upon every vehicle to be registered. The fee shall accrue and shall be collectible upon each vehicle under the same circumstances and shall be payable in the same manner and times as apply to vehicle registrations under the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; provided, the fee shall be paid in full for the then current year at the time any vehicle is first registered in a calendar year.

B. Revenue from the fee levied in subsection A of this section shall be transferred each month to the Department of Public Safety for deposit in the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund.

C. The collection and payment of the fee specified in this section shall be a prerequisite to licensing or registration of any vehicles.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2004.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
