AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S. 2001, Section 27-110, which relates to court marshal duties; updating language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 27-110, is amended to read as follows:

Section 27-110. The municipal governing body, upon the recommendation of the judge of the municipal court, may designate any appropriate person who is a resident of the municipality to serve as marshal, and in the absence of such a designation, the chief of police or corresponding officer of the municipality shall be ex officio marshal of the court. The marshal shall execute any writs and other process directed to ~~him~~ the marshal, except as ~~herein~~ otherwise provided, and such duty may be performed by any deputy marshal or by any members of the police force of the municipality, as the case may be.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
