HOUSE BILL HB2270:

Coleman

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1378, which relates to activities associated with causing serious bodily harm or death; requiring intent to cause serious bodily harm or death; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1378, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1378. A. Any person who shall plan, attempt, conspire or endeavor to perform an act of violence ~~involving or intended to involve~~ with the intent to cause serious bodily harm or death ~~of to~~ another person shall be guilty of a felony, punishable upon conviction thereof by imprisonment for a period of not more than ten (10) years.

B. Any person who shall threaten to perform an act of violence ~~involving or intended to involve~~ with the intent to cause serious bodily harm or death ~~of to~~ another person shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction thereof by imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not more than six (6) months.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
