HOUSE BILL HB2298:

Blackwell

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; directing the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education to make certain grants; establishing amount of the grants based on program cost tiers; providing for calculation of a vocational education teacher salary; limiting additional months allowed; providing for calculation of each additional month allowed; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-105.1 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall from funds appropriated each year, provide grants in amounts not less than Eight Thousand Ninety-six Dollars (\$8,096.00) and not more than Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$14,400.00) in tiers based on program cost adopted by the Department for each vocational education teacher program approved for reimbursement by the Department.

B. The salary of a vocational education teacher shall be calculated, subject to the approval of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, on the basis of the month for which the teacher is actually employed, but shall not exceed two (2) months in addition to the school year as defined in Section 1-109 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. For each additional month the teacher is employed, the additional salary shall be calculated on the basis of one-tenth (1/10) of the base salary prescribed by the

school district for a teacher of equal qualifications employed on a ten-month basis.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2004.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
