HOUSE BILL HB2479:

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to contracts; requiring certain advertisements to disclose design information; requiring advertisement to include statement on image modification; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 753.1 of Title 15, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Advertisements showing a sale price for televisions displayed at any retail establishment in this state shall also provide design specifications, including but not limited to, size, weight, resolution, and sound. In addition, in conspicuous type, the advertisement shall state that certain reception signals may require that an image be modified in order to display on the screen.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.

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
