HOUSE BILL HB2514:

Armes

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to juvenile justice; stating legislative findings; directing the Office of Juvenile Affairs to expend funds for youth program; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Legislature finds that effective youth programs deter gang activity, drug and alcohol abuse, and teen pregnancy. The Office of Juvenile Affairs shall expend sufficient funds to support effective youth programs offered by the Kennedy Youth Center of the Community Action Development Corporation.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
