HOUSE BILL HB2609:

Peterson (Ron)

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1740, which relates to the Pump Pirates Act; adding penalties for subsequent convictions; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1740, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1740. Any person who pumps gasoline into the gasoline tank of a vehicle and leaves the premises where the gasoline was pumped without making payment for the gasoline shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or confinement in the county jail for a period of not more than sixty (60) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. A person convicted of a second violation of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or confinement in the county jail for a period of not more than one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment. A person convicted of a third or subsequent violation of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by a fine of not more than Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), or imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for not more than two (2) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
