HOUSE BILL HB2637:

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; authorizing the enactment of ordinances for motor-driven cycles; defining term; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-1116 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any municipal governing body may enact ordinances governing the operation of motor-driven cycles upon the roads, streets, alleys, bridges, sidewalks, or other places within the municipality in the manner provided by, and not inconsistent with, state law. As used in this section, the term "motor-driven cycle" shall include, but not be limited to, motor scooters, motorized skateboards, mopeds, gopeds, and minibikes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
