HOUSE BILL HB2689:

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to higher education; encouraging the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to review its policies on residency to assist dependents of certain United States State Department employees; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Legislature hereby encourages the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to review its state residency policies for tuition and fees, scholarship, and financial aid purposes to ensure that dependents of employees of the United States State Department who are stationed outside the United States but have retained Oklahoma residency are not charged out-of-state tuition and have the opportunity to participate in all state scholarship and financial aid programs as residents.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
