HOUSE BILL HB2719:

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to cities and towns; providing for lapse and reversion of ordinances under certain circumstances; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 43-116 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Municipal zoning ordinances regarding land use or planned unit developments adopted by a municipal governing body after the effective date of this act shall lapse and revert to the previous zoning classification two (2) years from the date the ordinance was adopted, if no development of the affected area begins within the two (2) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2004.
