RESOLUTION HCR1037

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution removing certain designation of the bridge crossing the Canadian River on State Highway 4 between State Highway 152 and State Highway 37; directing the State Department of Transportation to remove any permanent markers; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, during the 2nd Session of the 48th Oklahoma Legislature, the Oklahoma House of Representatives with the Senate concurring therein passed House Concurrent Resolution 1081; and

WHEREAS, House Concurrent Resolution 1081 named a bridge crossing the Canadian River on State Highway 4 as "Schrock's Ferry Crossing"; and

WHEREAS, other interested parties that have come forth with additional recommendations for the naming of such bridge are unable to arrive at a consensus at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the bridge crossing the Canadian River on State Highway 4 between State Highway 152 and State Highway 37 not be designated as "Schrock's Ferry Crossing".

THAT the Oklahoma Department of Transportation refrain from or remove any permanent and suitable markers which may have been placed on the bridge bearing that name.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Secretary of Transportation, the Director of Transportation, and to the members of the State Transportation Commission.
