HOUSE JOINT

RESOLUTION HJR1039:

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 45 to Article X; authorizing certain indebtedness; requiring designation of capital projects; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 45 to Article X thereof, to read as follows:

The State of Oklahoma shall be authorized to become indebted in an amount not to exceed Zero Dollars (\$0.00) for specifically designated capital projects.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure would amend the Oklahoma Constitution. It would add a new Section 45 to Article 10. It would authorize the State of Oklahoma to become indebted. The debt could not exceed Zero

Dollars (\$0.00). The debt would be incurred for certain types of capital projects.

SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?

SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and file one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney General.
