HOUSE JOINT

RESOLUTION HJR1049:

Turner of the House

and

Gumm of the Senate

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 50 to Article X; authorizing indebtedness; specifying purpose of indebtedness; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 50 to Article X thereof, to read as follows:

Section 50. The State of Oklahoma shall be authorized to incur indebtedness in an amount not to exceed Zero Dollars (\$0.00) for purposes of constructing and improving roads and bridges in the state highway system.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It would add a new Section 50 to Article 10. It would allow the State of Oklahoma to borrow money. The money would be used to build and improve roads and bridges.

SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and file one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney General.
