AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution relating to the House Rules; amending Section 4 of House Rule 22 of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to conference committee reports; and modifying requirements for consideration of conference committee reports.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4 of House Rule 22 of the 49th Oklahoma Legislature is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. (a) A motion to adopt or reject a conference committee report shall be subject to debate. Such debate shall be limited to one (1) hour, equally divided between the proponents and the opponents of the motion.

(b) Prior to consideration, a conference committee report shall lie over twenty-four (24) hours after it ~~is filed.~~ ~~This subsection shall not apply on the last two (2) days of any legislative session once the date of the sine die adjournment has been set~~ distributed to every member.

(c) No measure for which a conference committee report has been adopted shall be considered unless each and every word of the measure has been recited orally from beginning to end before the House or the members of the House have been provided a printed copy or have individual floor access to the measure electronically.
