AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution declaring February 10, 2003, Panhandle Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol; welcoming visitors from the Oklahoma Panhandle; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, for the past ten years, mayors, city officials, government dignitaries, and interested citizens from Oklahoma's Panhandle region have gathered at the Oklahoma State Capitol to confer and consult with state legislative leaders; and

WHEREAS, on Monday, February 10, 2003, this annual event will be reenacted as civic leaders from communities in the Panhandle, including members of Leadership Oklahoma, will for the 11th consecutive year converge upon the Oklahoma State Capitol to demonstrate their appreciation for members of the Oklahoma State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Legislature always welcomes citizens and civic leaders to their state capitol, not just as guests, but as active participants in our republican form of government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives declares Monday, February 10, 2003, Panhandle Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives welcomes all visitors from the Oklahoma Panhandle who are participating in the 11th annual Panhandle Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol.
