AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution requesting the State Board of Career and Technology Education to direct a formal study of the funding issues relating to the career and technology programs in the public comprehensive high schools; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma career and technology system represents an important and integral component of the education system in Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the career technology programs in the public comprehensive high schools represent an important and integral component of the Oklahoma career and technology system; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Career and Technology Education and those representing the career technology programs in the public comprehensive high schools desire to take all steps necessary to improve the Oklahoma career and technology system as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education and those representing the career and technology programs in the public comprehensive high schools should work together to develop means by which to increase the funding for and therefore improve the career and technology programs in the public comprehensive high schools; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Career and Technology Education, as the body with oversight authority of the Oklahoma career and technology system, should take steps to adopt a funding system that supports an increase in funding to the career and technology

programs in the public comprehensive high schools, which will in turn improve the career and technology system as a whole.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives requests that the State Board of Career and Technology Education adopt a resolution directing the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education to undertake a formal study of the funding mechanisms and issues relating to the funding for career and technology programs in the public comprehensive high schools.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to State Board of Career and Technology Education and the Director of the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education.
