AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; authorizing notice of arrest for person driving unsafe vehicle; stating fine; authorizing the courts to dismiss charges under certain circumstances; authorizing the courts to dismiss court costs under certain circumstances; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 13-104 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

If the officer identifies a vehicle as unsafe or not equipped as set forth in paragraph (b) of Section 13-102 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the officer may give the driver a notice of arrest, stating a fine not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). Upon proof to the satisfaction of the court that the defect has been corrected, the court shall dismiss the charge upon payment of court costs. If the proof is submitted within seven (7) calendar days after the violation, the charge shall be dismissed without payment of court costs.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
