SENATE BILL 295

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating a portion of U.S. Highway 412 as "Trooper Chris Van Krevelen Memorial Highway"; directing the Department of Transportation to place suitable permanent markers on the highway; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1651 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

From where U.S. Highway 412 intersects with State Highway 74 in Garfield County, west to where the highway intersects with State Highway 58 in Enid, Oklahoma, shall be designated as "Trooper Chris Van Krevelen Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall place suitable permanent markers on the highway bearing the name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
