SENATE BILL 380

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating certain portion of U.S. Highway 77 as the "Purple Heart Highway"; requiring the Department of Transportation to place suitable permanent markers on the highway; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1654 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

U.S. Highway 77 where it intersects with Interstate Highway 44 in Comanche County, east to where it intersects with U.S. Highway 81 in Stephens County, shall be designated as the "Purple Heart Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent suitable markers to be placed on said highway bearing the name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
