SENATE BILL 581

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; prohibiting school districts from granting paid leave to certain employee representatives; requiring salary reduction to cover cost of providing substitute teacher under certain circumstances; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 509.12 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A school district shall not grant paid leave to employee representatives of an employee organization for the purpose of conducting business for the employee organization. The salary of an employee who takes leave to conduct business of the organization shall be reduced by the cost of providing a substitute teacher.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2003.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
