AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Flower; declaring the "Oklahoma Rose" as the Oklahoma State Flower; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.7 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The official state flower of the State of Oklahoma shall be the Oklahoma Rose.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2003.
