6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution declaring February 10, 2003, "Panhandle
8 Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol"; welcoming
9 visitors from the Oklahoma Panhandle; and directing
10 distribution.

12 WHEREAS, for the past ten years, mayors, city officials,
13 government dignitaries, and interested citizens from Oklahoma's
14 Panhandle region have gathered at the Oklahoma State Capitol to
15 confer and consult with state legislative leaders; and

16 WHEREAS, on Monday, February 10, 2003, this annual event will be
17 reenacted as civic leaders from communities in the Panhandle,
18 including members of Leadership Oklahoma, will for the 11th
19 consecutive year converge upon the Oklahoma State Capitol to share
20 their concerns and expectations with members of the Oklahoma State
21 Legislature; and

22 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Legislature always welcomes citizens
23 and civic leaders to their state capitol, not just as guests, but as
24 active participants in our republican form of government.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
26 OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

27 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate declares Monday, February 10,
28 2003, "Panhandle Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol".

29 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate welcomes all visitors from the
30 Oklahoma Panhandle who are participating in the 11th annual
31 "Panhandle Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol".
