AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution recognizing the Owasso Rams as Class 6A baseball champions; congratulating the team and coach Larry Turner; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Owasso Rams won the Class 6A baseball championship with a 10-5 victory over Putnam North on Saturday, May 17, 2003, in front of 2,000 fans at Mitchell Park in Norman, Oklahoma. The Rams finished the season with a 36-4 record, winning their last 18 games. Two years ago they had a 25-game winning streak; and

WHEREAS, Coach Larry Turner of the Owasso Rams baseball team recently achieved a professional milestone by winning his 600th career victory with a 5-4 victory at Bartlesville, Oklahoma. At that time Coach Turner had coached twenty-one years at Owasso, with a 600-178 record, a .771 winning percentage, and had already won four state titles in 1987, 1998, 1999, and 2001. His team triumphed again last weekend.
