AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution expressing gratitude to Senator Mark Snyder for his service in the Oklahoma State Senate; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Mark Snyder is completing his seventeenth year of service to the citizens of Senate District 41 in the Oklahoma State Senate; and

WHEREAS, Mark Snyder was born in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on August 14, 1946, to Fred P. and Alice Snyder. He is married to Dianne (Garmany) and is the father of Shele and Leah. He is a graduate of Oklahoma State University and served as a Captain in the United States Army and on the Edmond City Council; and

WHEREAS, Mark Snyder was elected to the Oklahoma State Senate in 1987 and served as Minority Floor Leader from 1998 to 2000. He currently serves as vice-chair of the Committee on Aerospace and Technology; and

WHEREAS, State Question 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for members of the Legislature to a total of twelve years and as a result thereof, Senator Mark Snyder will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year; and

WHEREAS, Senator Mark Snyder will be missed for his quiet and dignified advocacy on behalf of Oklahoma businesses, his knowledge of the operations of local government, and his consistently

conservative and responsible approach to tax reform and other fiscal matters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
