AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending the Southeast High School Spartans boys basketball team for winning the Class 5A Boys Basketball State Championship; praising their record; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Southeast High School Spartans boys basketball team had a 43-game, regular-season winning streak which snapped in February, when they lost their first regular-season game since the 2001-02 basketball season. Despite the loss, which came at the hands of a team they had beaten handily a week earlier, the Spartans still finished their 2003-04 season with a 26-1 record; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast High School Spartans boys basketball team won all of its tournament games during the 2003-04 season, although they frequently fell behind early in the game only to rally for a victory during the last minutes or even seconds of the contest. In at least one of the tournaments the Spartans played teams in Class 6A, but still prevailed in all their tournament games including the regional, area, and state playoffs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends and congratulates the Southeast High School Spartans Class 5A boys basketball team for winning the All City Conference Basketball Preview Championship; All City Conference Championship; Shriners Classic Championship played in Muskogee, Oklahoma; John Nobles Tournament Championship played in

Moore, Oklahoma; Class 5A West Regional Championship; Class 5A West Area Championship; and Class 5A Boys Basketball State Championship.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate praises the Southeast High School Spartans Class 5A boys basketball team on their 26-1 record for the 2003-04 season and their undefeated record during basketball tournaments.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Southeast High School Principal Rafael White, Athletic Director Gary Cruzen, Head Basketball Coach Walter Brewer, and Assistant Basketball Coaches Lamont Lowe and Andy Chishko.
