AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution expressing gratitude to Senator Jim Dunlap for his service in the Oklahoma State Senate; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Jim Dunlap is completing his sixteenth year of service in the Legislature and his eighth year of service to the citizens of District 29 in the Oklahoma State Senate; and

WHEREAS, Jim Dunlap was born in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, on March 10, 1961, to Kenneth J. and Levah (Bishop) Dunlap. He is married to Pam (Thompson) and is the father of Harrison and Preston, with a new baby expected within the month. He is a graduate of Drury College in Springfield, Missouri, holds a Master's Degree from Northeastern State University, and is in the construction profession; and

WHEREAS, Jim Dunlap has served in the Oklahoma State Senate since 1997, having previously served in the House of Representatives, and served as Minority Floor Leader from 2001 to 2003. He served as national chair of the American Legislative Exchange Council in 2002, and is a member of the State and Local Officials Senior Advisory Committee to the Homeland Security Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, State Question 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for members of the Legislature to a total of twelve years and as a result thereof, Senator Jim Dunlap will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year; and

WHEREAS, Jim Dunlap has been known and will long be remembered for his keen intelligence and grasp of difficult issues, for his willingness to work with those of all legislative stripes for the good of this state, and for his kind and decent treatment of all he encountered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate, on behalf of the citizens of Senate District 29 and all citizens of this state, expresses its gratitude to Senator Jim Dunlap for his service in the Oklahoma State Senate.
