AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution expressing gratitude to Senator Maxine Cissel Horner for her service in the Oklahoma State Senate; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Maxine Cissel Horner is completing her eighteenth year of service to the citizens of District 11 in the Oklahoma State Senate; and

WHEREAS, Maxine Cissel Horner was born in Tulsa, Oklahoma, on January 17, 1933. She was married to Donald M. Horner and is the mother of Shari Horner-Tisdale and Donald Horner, Jr. She is a graduate of Langston University and worked as a congressional staff assistant, director of the Minority Women's Employment Program for the United States Department of Labor and personnel administrator for the Tulsa Job Corps; and

WHEREAS, Maxine Cissel Horner has served in the Oklahoma State Senate since 1986 and currently serves as chair of the Committee on Business and Labor. During her tenure in the Senate, she has been a quiet and effective advocate, particularly for the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program, the Oklahoma Jazz Hall of Fame, the victims of the 1921 Tulsa race riot, and equal rights for all persons; and

WHEREAS, State Question 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for members of the Legislature to a total of twelve years and as a result thereof, Senator Maxine Cissel Horner will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year; and

WHEREAS, Maxine Cissel Horner leaves a legacy of commitment on behalf of the causes she championed, and all citizens of this state are better off for her service in the Senate, none more so than those who value really good jazz music.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 49TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate, on behalf of the citizens of Senate District 11 and all citizens of this state, expresses its gratitude to Senator Maxine Cissel Horner for her service in the Oklahoma State Senate.
